Important Reminders

The Village Office has received numerous noise complaints regarding the use of ATVs and snowmobiles within Village Limits. This is a reminder that Bylaw No. 114/87 states it is unlawful to operate snowmobiles, dirt bikes, unlicensed vehicles, unlicensed motorcycles and all terrain vehicles on roads within the boundaries of the Village. This includes quads, trikes and bikes. Fines from the Village begin at \$25 per offense. If you have a complaint, please provide the details in writing to the Village Office or call the RCMP.

Dog licenses are available and are now due. If you have not already done so, please drop by the office and get your new dog tag. Can't make it to the office? Drop your \$20 licensing fee with the breed, color, sex, and name of your dog and I'll send your tag in the mail.

We are experiencing some issues regarding recycling. Cardboard boxes should be flattened before putting in the Loraas bin.
