What's Up in the Village Office?

In October, the Village Office announced new winter hours. During the months from October until June the Office is open Monday - Friday 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM. From July - September the Office is open Monday's and Tuesday's 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM and Wednesday's 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM.

Here's a couple reminders:

At the Ratepayer's meeting in June, we announced the availability of funding for a home day care. Anyone interested in opening a day care in their home may be eligible for \$1,000 / child to a maximum of \$5,000. Proposals should be submitted for Council's review.

The 4th quarter utility bills have been issued. You will want to ensure you pay your water / sewer account by December 31st. During year end activities, outstanding water / sewer charges are transferred to your tax account and, January 1st, will begin to accumulate a 2% penalty per month.
