With spring on its way thoughts turn to home and garden improvements. Village of Sedley Bylaw # 3/03 indicates that all developments require a building permit. Building permits can be purchased from the Village Office by submitting 2 copies of your building / improvement plan and a \$25 fee. Once your plans have been approved a Building Permit will be issued. All renovations / improvements started without a building permit will be issued a stop order until approval is granted and a building permit is issued.

Does Sedley have a RAT problem?

There have been rat sightings in Sedley recently. We called in our local pest control man and he indicates that we do NOT have rats. Those rats that have been sighted are considered 'transient rats' (that's official pest control terminology) and are not making themselves at home in our community. Should you spot a rat, please contact the Village Office at 885-2133. To prevent rats from making a home in your yard, please keep all garbage in containers, clean up debris in your yard and most importantly **DON'T FEED THE WILDLIFE** such as squirrels.
