BYLAW INFO

Lately, the Village Office has received numerous complaints regarding the use of ATVs within Village Limits. This is a reminder that Bylaw No. 114/87 states that ‘...it is unlawful to operate snowmobiles, dirt bikes, unlicensable vehicles, unlicenseable motorcycles and all terrain vehicles on roads within the boundaries of the Village.’ This includes quads, trikes and bikes. Fines from the Village begin at \$25 per offense. If you have a complaint, please provide the details in writing to the Village Office or call the R.C.M.P.

Two new bylaws were passed by Village Council at the August Council meeting:

Open Fire Bylaw – This bylaw allows for open fires for cooking or other recreational purposes provided the fire is in a fireplace, grill, BBQ or fire pit receptacle. The burning of waste including rubbish, garbage or scrap, hazardous materials or any materials that generate black smoke or an offensive odour is not permitted.

Swimming Pool Bylaw - The Swimming Pool bylaw has been amended from the previous bylaw. A permit is still required to have a pool in the Village, but there is no longer a permit fee. The purpose of the permit is to ensure the other elements of the bylaw, such as being fenced properly and having safety devices on hand are being followed.

Copies of bylaws are available at the Village Office for a small copying charge. Should you wish to make a complaint please provide the details in writing to the Village Office.
