Odd / Even Watering

Odd / even watering will begin May 1st. This means if your home address is an even number (2, 4, 6, etc.) you will water on even numbered days. If your home address is an odd number (1, 3, 5, etc.) you will water on odd numbered days. This way of watering lawns and gardens will be implemented in May each year.
