



June 15th Council Meeting Synopsis

The following decisions were made by council at the regular council meeting held June 15th:

- Maintenance on the tennis court including securing the net posts with new cement and re-painting the court lines
- 2nd and 3rd reading of the new Council Procedures Bylaw seeing the bylaw come into force on its day of passing, June 15th. Full details of the bylaw can be found on our website.
- A decision to transition the landfill to a transfer station was confirmed. This means an eventual decommission of the current household garbage cell. Household garbage will be picked up by Loraas Disposal. Roll out date to be determined. Landfill will continue to operate, with few moderations. Stay tuned for more details.
- A bylaw to extend the submission of financial statements to the Ministry of Government Relations was introduced and given three readings. It comes into force the day of its passing, June 15th. There is a requirement to submit financial statements to the Ministry by July 1st. There is currently a backlog at the municipal auditor's office, which may impact our ability to meet this deadline.
- The office received an offer to purchase 225 Francis Street for \$9,500. This offer was accepted.
