



## Council Meeting Synopsis

The following decisions have been made by council at the August 3<sup>rd</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup> meetings:

### August 3<sup>rd</sup>

- We will be proceeding with replacing the sidewalk from the library to the office. We are currently awaiting one more quote before proceeding with the project.
- Final phase of the ditch sculpting project will begin the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of August.
- Chris Stevens, Fire Chief attended the meeting and provided an update on the fire department. Chris will also assume the responsibility of registering and maintaining the AEDs in the village.
- The rail crossing which runs west of the grain elevators will be abandoned. Stewart Southern Railway will manage this process.
- Bob Baker was appointed the weed inspector for Sedley.

### August 17<sup>th</sup>

- We received a letter from CanPacific advising the test cavern project will proceed. Those wanting additional information are invited to attend an open house at Sedley New Horizon's on September 22<sup>nd</sup> 4 PM – 8 PM.
- We had a robust discussion about the future of garbage service in Sedley. We are also going to try and secure a backup landfill custodian in an effort to reduce impact to service delivery going forward.
- We will be receiving additional Gas Tax funds from the government and a variety of projects were discussed. These projects will be submitted to the province for approval and may not proceed until 2022.
- The old GMC fire truck, which has been out of service for quite some time, will be listed for sale for \$4,000.
- The garbage truck, which is no longer needed due to the transition to curbside garbage pickup, will be listed for \$22,500.
