



Council Meeting Synopsis

The following decisions have been made by council at the October 19th meeting:

- This council meeting had 2 delegations attend:
 - Brad Brown spoke at the council meeting in an effort to improve the relationship between Village of Sedley council and staff. The decision to continue to have media and information requests funneled through a centralized point via the office was decided. Council feels the most complete and speedy access to information is available from office staff.
 - Shaun Folden of Harvard Western Insurance attended the meeting to review the Village insurance policy. This review is conducted annually to ensure our assets (such as building, infrastructure and equipment) are insured adequately in the event of a loss.
- An exciting and different Christmas event was discussed – stay tuned for more details in our November newsletter!
- Vos Industries will be contracted to sort through the cement pile at the newly converted transfer station. Those pieces which can be transported and/or broken into smaller pieces will be used at the lagoon to fortify berm walls at the lagoon.
- New Deal funds advanced from the Province in the amount of \$43,622 will be invested in a 1 year fixed GIC. These funds are slated for specific projects as per the agreement with the Province of Saskatchewan which include, but are not limited to lighting at the spray park, sidewalk upgrades and a wheel chair ramp at the Gym Hall.
- As required by legislation the Annual Declaration of Council was completed by all members and filed at the Office.
- A new boardwalk will be built and installed at the corner of Martin Street and Prairie Avenue.
- A new speed limit sign will be ordered for Prairie Avenue by the school to improve visibility.
- Rather than rehang/repairing the Christmas lights on the tree in front of the office, it was decided spotlights would be purchased to light the tree and the Village Office sign.
- The List of Lands in Arrears was provided to council and approved as amended.
- The Village will submit an ad for the Sedley Community Council School Cookbook initiative to be published sometime in November.
- Management recommended the hiring of a new caretaker for the office, gym hall, library and seasonally at the spray park.
