Parking

Please do not park in ditches – it makes Al's job more difficult regardless of the season.

Also, we've noticed a number of people are parking trucks and/or cars on the sidewalk. Parking on the sidewalk interferes with residents out walking, children playing or riding their bikes, not to mention damage to the sidewalk over time. Please do not park on or over sidewalks.

Bill Payments

Depending on the financial institution you deal with, the office receives notification of payments made online differently – some send notification when you make the payment and some when it forwards the money to our bank account. Effective immediately, if you are paying your water/sewer or property taxes using online banking and make the payment near the end of the month and it is not received into our bank account by the last day of the month, it will be posted in the month in which it is received. This could cause interest to be added to your account. Please consider adjusting your payment date.

We have many options for your utility and/or tax payments:


- Cash or cheque (post dated works too!)
- e-Transfer (If you are using this option, please indicate your address and whether it's a utility or a tax payment)
- Online banking via your financial institution's website

A reminder your 4th quarter water/sewer payment is due December 31st as is 2021 property tax payment. The office will be closed between Christmas and New Year's. Payments made by cash or cheque dated December 31st and received in the office by 9:00 AM on January 4th will be backdated to December 31st. This does not apply to online payments received after December 31st.

Street Light Issues

www.saskpower.com has an easy to use tool to report problems with street lights. We are encouraging everyone to report issues as SaskPower has begun exchanging the old street lights with brighter, more efficient LED street lights. This results in savings for us and our community is so much brighter at night!
