



Council Meeting Synopsis

The following decisions have been made by council at the November 18th meeting:

- Al will take a drive around the village and have gravel applied to those icy intersections.
- The Christmas stars should be twinkling from the street lights in the next couple weeks.
- A resolution was made to have SAMA (Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency) conduct an assessment review of properties in Sedley. An on-site assessment review has not been conducted since 1989. This initiative will begin in early 2022. Residents can expect to receive communication from SAMA outlining the process at that time.
- We received 2 offers to purchase the garbage truck. The offer of \$18,000 was accepted and anticipated delivery to its new owner is November 29th.
- A resolution was made confirming we are compliant with all criteria required to continue to receive the Municipal Revenue Share grant from the province. The 2021 Revenue Share amount was \$82,342 which is up 139% from 15 years ago.
- Council was presented and adopted 2 bylaws – The Sedley Transfer Station Bylaw and The Sedley Waste Management Bylaw. Should you wish to view these, please check the Bylaw page of our website at www.villageofsedley.com.

Committee Reports

Fire Department

- The Fire Department was gifted an 80-amp Milwaukee battery pack from colleagues of the fire chief, Chris Stevens. This tool will be extremely beneficial when responding to remote fire calls.
- With the onset on cold weather, outside training activities will be suspended for the season.

Sedley Memorial Rink

- Chase the Ace is still going! The weekly prize of \$558 was won by Kelly Deck. The big prize of approximately \$18,500 was not won! So far the Rink has raised over \$30,000 to continue operations. See a member of the Rink Board for tickets!
- The Rink was a recipient of Affinity Credit Union's community grant program. These funds were used to install a new door with opener to the Zamboni room and install a new 40-gallon water heater. Cost of these upgrades were \$5,390.10.
- The Rink Board is busy preparing to open the Rink for the 2021-22 season. This will be dependent on public health guidelines implemented by the Province. As it stands right now, the Board feels it will be able to meet all the guidelines.
- The Village applied for and was granted \$2,500 to assist with day to day operations of the Rink under the Community Rink Affordability Grant.

Sedley Gym Hall

- The Gym Hall Board is planning some much needed upgrades to the facility in the coming months. The front entrance will soon have new flooring, the old water fountain will be removed, new paint and new ceiling tiles will finish off the space nicely! In spring, the steel entrance doors will receive a fresh coat of paint.

Sedley Parks & Rec

- All submissions were approved by the province and we have received a cheque in the amount of \$5,063 for the 2022 grant period.

Sedley Branch Library

- The budget for 2022 was approved by Southeast Regional Library. We anticipate at \$0.30 per capita increase. This increase will be based on 2021 census results which will be release in February 2022.

There were no reports from Sedley New Horizon's or the Prairie Lily boards.
