



Council Meeting Synopsis December 20th, 2021

The following decisions were made at the council meeting held December 20th, 2021:

The Kid's Shopping Event at the Sedley branch Library was a great success! 70 children took part in the event.

The gas connections at 324 & 328 Martin Crescent will be removed by SaskEnergy.

We were presented a unique fundraising opportunity by the company which purchased the garbage truck. This company will deliver live Christmas trees for sale in the community. This information will be shared with the numerous volunteer boards in Sedley to see if one is interested in pursuing this opportunity.

Insurance for the volunteer Fire Department was approved. This offers insurance should one of our fire team be injured while protecting our community.

As required by legislation, Western Municipal has been appointed as the Board of Revisions. The Board of Revisions will review any assessment appeals submitted by residents.

2 generous donations were received from CanPacific Potash - \$8,000 for improvements at Sedley Gym Hall and \$2,000 for SSAY Green which will be used to purchase flowers for summer 2022.

Lots 13, 14 18 & 19, Block 2, Plan B2867 will be sold by sealed tender, submitted to the auditor for Sedley – Dudley & Company. Tenders are to be submitted to the auditor. All tenders will be reviewed by the auditor and the 'winning' bid will be awarded by the auditor. Neither management or council will see any of the submitted tenders.

A letter will be sent to the Minister of Public Safety, local MLA, Minister of Corrections & Policing and the President of Federation of Canadian Municipalities regarding the proposed increase in policing costs related to the decision to provide retroactive pay to all RCMP for the last 5 years. This decision was made at a Federal level and should not be downloaded on to municipalities.

Committee Updates

Sedley Fire Department – no update.

Sedley Rink – Chase the Ace is still on! There are 7 cards left. Public skating has started and there are some rentals scheduled prior to year end.

Sedley Gym Hall – We are so appreciative to receive a grant of \$8,000 from CanPacific Potash. These funds will be used to complete several upgrades to the facility.
