Business licenses are \$25/year for home-based business and \$100/year for commercial businesses.

Bill Payments

Depending on the financial institution you deal with, the office receives notification of payments made online differently – some send notification when you make the payment and some when it forwards the money to our bank account. Effective immediately, if you are paying your water/sewer or property taxes using online banking and make the payment near the end of the month and it is not received into our bank account by the last day of the month, it will be posted in the month in which it is received. This could cause interest to be added to your account. Please consider adjusting your payment date.

We have many options for your utility and/or tax payments:

- Cash or cheque (post dated works too!)
- e-Transfer (If you are using this option, please indicate your address and whether it's a utility or a tax payment)
- Online banking via your financial institution's website

The first quarter water/sewer bill has been sent. If you receive billings via e-mail, please check your junk/spam folder. Also ensure you have added @villageofsedley.com to your safe/white list. Payment is due March 31st.
