

A BYLAW AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF CENTRAL STANDARD TIME

The Council of the Village of Sedley, of the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows;-

1. This village hereby adopts for the regulation of business hours within the village the time known as Central Standard Time, being one hour in advance of Mountain Standard Time.
2. The said time shall be observed throughout the year in each and every year during the continuance of this bylaw.
3. Every place of business within the village during the said period in each and every year shall be operated on and business shall be carried on accordingly to Central Standard Time.
4. Wherever reference is made to any hour of the day in any bylaw of the village, such hour shall - unless the context otherwise requires - be deemed to refer to and mean Central Standard Time.
5. In all bylaws hereafter passed by the Council of this village where a time is mentioned, such time shall be Central Standard Time, provided that such time shall not conflict with the general or the Statute Law of this Province of the Dominion of Canada.
