



Council Meeting Synopsis
May 17th, 2022

The following decisions were made at the council meeting held May 17th, 2022:

At the budget meeting in February 2022, council made a motion to purchase an additional 70 trees from U & K Greenhouse, Indian Head. These will be used to replace any trees planted in the new subdivision in 2021 which did not winter well and the remainder will be planted in the spray park area or other green space.

The building previously used as the Village shop located on the corner of Assiniboia Avenue & Martin Street will be listed for sale in June. Contents of the old shop/youth centre will be sorted and items listed for sale. The Labelle sign will be sold with the building and the Greenhouse Committee will be given first right of refusal to move the building to another location otherwise, it will be sold with the property.

Management will amend the Zoning Bylaw to update the definition of discretionary uses of the properties on the 300 block of Martin Street. This definition will allow development applications for the placement of new mobile homes to be reviewed by council on a case by case basis.

Broadway Street sidewalk project is slated to begin May 24th (weather permitting, of course). We expect there to be inconveniences – we are replacing sidewalks from the library to the Hotel – and we are asking for your patience while this project is ongoing. Additional information regarding the project roll out will be sent once finalized. We thank you for your cooperation during this time.

2 new building inspectors from Professional Building Inspections were approved for development/building permits in the Village.

It was decided the tennis court net would not be hung this year as many of our children are using the space to play shinny/road hockey.

The effluent levels in the lagoon are unseasonably high. Public Works will be meet with our Environmental Protection Officer to discuss options.

The next meeting of council will be June 21st at 7:00 PM at the Village Office.

Committee Updates

Sedley Fire Department – Attendance at the last meeting was limited as many members of our Fire Team are currently working in the field. The purchase of a new spray to spread water/foam mix was approved.

Sedley Parks & Rec – Parks & Rec Board met this month. At the meeting, the Board distributed \$5,063 to various volunteer groups including Sedley Preschool, Sedley Gym Hall. Sedley Spray Park Committee submitted a grant request to purchase tables for the park. Parks & Rec Committee approved the purchase of 2 tables at a cost of approximately \$2,000. Next Parks & Recreation meeting will be held in November.
