WHEREAS municipalities are not required to obtain approval from Saskatchewan Municipal Board for increases to the base tax, minimum tax and/or mill rate.

WHEREAS approval from Saskatchewan Municipal Board is required as per Section 23(3)(a) states '...the rates, charges, tolls or rents set by a council by bylaw for the use of water or sewer services' ...even for small incremental amounts.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT Saskatchewan Urban Municipalities Association lobby the Provincial government to amend *The Municipalities Act* to remove the requirement of Saskatchewan Municipal Board approval for increases to public utilities.
