## **Parks & Recreation**

Each year we receive a grant from Sask Lotteries for parks and recreation here in Sedley. In 2022, \$5,063 was distributed as follows:

Sedley Branch Library - \$822.93 Sedley Rink - \$358.20 Sedley Preschool - \$640.95 Sedley New Horizon's - \$640.95 SSAY Green - \$640.95 Sedley School Council - \$1,509.01

#### **Parking**

There are a number of homes where vehicles/trailers are parked either blocking the sidewalk or parked with one axle on the sidewalk. Over time, this can cause sidewalks to deteriorate due to the weight of vehicles. Please refrain from parking vehicles/trailers on or blocking the sidewalks.

# **Ditch Sculpting Initiative**

As you've noticed, the ditch sculpting has begun on the 100 block of Broadway Street. You can anticipate the parking interruption for a few more days. Please be respectful of our contract and ensure you park in a way which does not interfere with the project. We thank you for your cooperation.

# **Making Payments**

There are a variety of payment methods to pay your water/sewer, property taxes, business and/or dog license:

- Cash
- Cheque
- Via your financial institutions online banking portal, or
- Interac e-transfer®

When paying by Interac e-transfer®, please ensure you indicate what your payment is for (i.e. water/sewer/taxes/business or dog license, etc.) so the funds can be allocated properly.

If you usually pay water/sewer or tax payments on or near the end of the month, please consider moving your payment date to no later than the 25<sup>th</sup> of the month. Some financial institutions take 3-4 business days to advance the funds which results in the fund deposited in our account after the last day of the month. Going forward, payments will be receipted when the monies are received which may result in the payment being late, and interest will be charged accordingly.

## **Rapid Tests**

Rapid tests are still available at the Village Office during business hours.

## **Dogs & Cats Oh My!**

Just a couple friendly reminders about your pets. Please have your dogs (and cats) on a leash at all times. Neither cats or dogs should be roaming at large at any time.

Also, please clean up after your pet. There is a garbage can and poop bags available at the tennis court...please keep our tennis court clean.
