Bylaw No. 2025-7

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A DEVELOPMENT APPEAL FEE

The Council of the Village of Sedley, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be referred to as the “Development Appeal Fee Bylaw”.
2. In this bylaw:
 - a) “Act” shall mean “*The Planning and Development Act, 2007*”;
 - b) “Board” shall mean the
 - i) Development Appeal Board established by the Municipality; or
 - ii) District Development Appeal Board which has been created by the Municipality in partnership with other municipalities;
 - c) “Municipality” shall mean the Village of Sedley;
 - d) “Secretary” shall mean the Secretary to the Development Appeal Board.
3. A fee of \$250.00 per appeal is hereby established for the purpose of filing an appeal to the Board.
4. The applicable fee shall be payable to the Municipality and be paid at the time of filing the appeal.
5. Where an appellant fails to pay the applicable fee pursuant to Sections 3 and 4 of this bylaw, the appeal is deemed to be dismissed.
6. This Bylaw comes into force on the day of its final passing.
