Town Hall Meeting

Once again, A Town Hall Meeting is being held this year! Join us on Monday, June 15th at the Gym Hall to learn more about what Council and Administration have planned for this year and have a chance to give us your direct feedback!

The regular council meeting for June will be held immediately after the town hall meeting if you wish to stick around and attend!

Reminder – Regular Council Meetings are open to the public for observation. If you wish to bring something forward to council and discuss it with them, simply contact the office at least one week prior to the meeting to be added to the Agenda.



Parking Reminder

This is a reminder to NOT park in the ditch. When vehicles are parked in the ditch it can impede water flow, cause ruts and damage, and interfere with grass cutting.

This is also a reminder to avoid parking on the street for extended periods of time. When parking on the street, it's also important to remember to not create any blind spots, especially around intersections. These can decrease the safety in our community and impede road maintenance.

Spray Park

We are excited to once again turn on the spray park for the summer! Opening day is Saturday, June 20th, weather permitting.

Hours: Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday & Sunday
11am-7pm

Please ensure that all children are supervised at all times and that they are not sitting or climbing on the equipment.



Dogs

We are reminding you to **please pick up after your pets!** Whether it's in the streets or in a yard, doing your part to clean up helps keep our community looking nice and is respectful to your neighbours.

This is also a reminder that dogs are **not** allowed in the Spray Park or the Tennis Court. If you have not yet purchased your licence for 2026, please come down to the office or send your \$20 per dog (along with a description of your dog(s)) to the Office as soon as possible.

Summer Reminders

With the warm weather arriving, there are a few things you should keep in mind:

- **Watering Schedule**
 - The Watering Schedule for the Village is an Odd/Even Calendar Days Schedule. If your home is an odd number, then you water on odd calendar days of the month. If it is an even number, then you water on even calendar days of the month. This schedule is effective immediately.
- **Clear Sidewalks**
 - Please make sure to trim your bushes and shrubs away from the sidewalk! When the sidewalks are infringed upon, it greatly reduces accessibility and safety for pedestrians.
- **ATVs & Golf Carts**

- ATVs and golf carts are NOT to be driven within the Village. You can fuel up your ATV at the store and take your fun out of town. Unlicensable vehicles are not permitted as per Sedley’s ATV bylaw and *The All Terrain Vehicles Act*.
- **Fires**
 - Just a reminder that only clean wood is allowed to be burned in outside fire pits. No garbage, plastics, oil or toxic materials!
- **Campers and Trailers**
 - It’s camping season!!! We’d like to remind everyone to not obstruct sidewalks with their trailer or hitch when parking your camper in between camping trips. Also, please do not park on the street for an extended period of time and try not to create blind spots – especially at an intersection. Lastly, please refrain from parking your camper in drainage ditches. Parking in the ditch when it is wet causes ruts and other damage which is costly to repair. It also hinders grass cutting and ditch maintenance.

Email Consent Form

The Village of Sedley offers residents the opportunity to join an email list to receive regular Newsletters and occasional Surveys.

- Email senders can easily misaddress an email.
- Email is easier to falsify than handwritten or signed documents.
- Emails can be intercepted, altered, forwarded, or used without authorization or detection.
- Email can be used to introduce viruses into computer systems.

The Village of Sedley will use reasonable means to protect the security and confidentiality of email information sent and received. However, because of the risks outlined above, the municipality cannot guarantee the security and confidentiality of email communication and will not be liable for improper disclosing of confidential information.

Consent to receiving emails from the Village includes agreement with the following:

1. I will inform the Village of Sedley of any changes in my email address as soon as possible, to prevent the misdirection of emails and reduce the risk of not receiving important information.
2. I may withdraw from email delivery at any time. To do so, I will inform the Village of Sedley and all future emails will not be delivered to me unless I re-opt in.
